Different things to use in pots - styrofoam "beans",
fiberglass on bottom to keep bugs out + soil in,
small stones, then soil - fill to top of containers,
osmocote - superphosphate - sprinkle small amount
PC Pipe gravel - filled - (easier to water) then
pull pipe out -

Add a pollimer - holds moisture in - sprinkle some
in soil - granules (moisture additive)

Never bring soil up above an inch or two - for room
to water. When finished put a saucer under it
& maybe on legs - for air circulation. Fill saucer
with pea gravel for drainage + circulation. Be sure
to work when you want large containers because it
will be too heavy to move.
